

GLEN DAY: Brandt Jobe played good. He lives in Dallas, plays in this every day, so it's nothing new to him. And I played solid. I hit the ball solid. I rolled some good putts. I made some, I missed some that I thought I made, but obviously I'm on top of the leaderboard, I'm happy.

Q. Two rounds and no bogeys, that's got to make you feel pretty good?

GLEN DAY: Oh, yeah, just found that out. The announcer's curse, they'll screw that up for tomorrow. Now I can forget about it and I don't have to worry about it.

Q. The wind, it was gusting. We thought the course was going to be fairly difficult. There were several good rounds out there, I mean how are so many people putting themselves in position out there?

GLEN DAY: Luckily, the greens are still fairly receptive. They're bouncing, I think they're perfect. I think the staff has done a wonderful job with the weather they've had because it could have got away from them really quick. I think the greens were good, the pin placements were good. People played good, also.

Q. You talked about the curse, but you're going back to this year, you got a real long streak without any bogeys, going back to the Senior PGA Championship. Are you just in a perfect spot now, you feel really comfortable with the swing and everything?

GLEN DAY: No, I don't think I'm swinging at it good, great. I don't think I'm hitting it as good as I did a while back. I just, I've been very good at staying in the present time and that's what golfers -- you know, you can hear being in the zone and that's kind of part of it. I'm not totally there, but I'm as good as I've been in a while. One shot, one putt, one whatever I'm doing, and then that's over and go to the next.

Q. Despite it being Sunday, is it the same attitude given the fact that the wind is going to be up?

GLEN DAY: Oh, a hundred percent, hundred percent.

Q. And then do you feel like then that the course will dry out anymore? Do you expect that?

GLEN DAY: Oh, yeah, it's drying out now. I don't know what they're going to do. I mean, they kept it very playable. Last year when we got here, it was firm, a lot firmer and faster. If it would have been that way the first of the week, it would have been almost unplayable right now. So I think the staff has done a phenomenal job.
