

Q. You're in contention, a couple strokes off the lead. How's it feel going into the final round here?

BERNHARD LANGER: Wish I was a little closer. I'm more than a couple, I'm four behind, I think, so that's a lot to make up. But it's happened before, so hopefully I will play better tomorrow. Made a lot of mistakes today, dropped five shots, made plenty of birdies but too many bogeys.

Q. Talk about the shot on 4, how did you feel when that went in?

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, that was a great feeling to -- I hit a perfect tee shot and really nice lob wedge from 80 yards, took a couple hops and then disappeared in the hole, it was a fantastic start.

Q. Do you feel that you're playing good this week here at Wakonda?

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, I was playing good. Today I hit a few bad shots, especially the one on 17 in the water and a couple other ones. Was unlucky with a bunker shot earlier on that was a good tee shot but it plugged in the bunker, the wind got it. So it's harder in the wind to control the distance and I got caught today.

Q. With the windy conditions, are you expecting more of the same tomorrow?

BERNHARD LANGER: Looks like it. Same wind direction and same strength. Shouldn't be any different.
